

#### Case: ERC Advanced Grants


- Award: 2.5mil EUR (+1) funding over 5 years
- Target: excellent researchers established in their careers (12+ years post PhD)
- Mission: groundbreaking, bottom-up research
- Success rate: 13.2% (2022)



### Status & recent developments

- 2023: significant changes to ERC AdG evaluation criteria: Concept prioritised over CV/track record of PI (previously equal weighting)\*
- Opportunity for UiB applicants to benefit from these changes
- Incentive to increase the number of AdG proposals sent from UiB
- Applicants are currently self-selecting & apply under own initiative
- Minimal active mobilisation local advertising of reading days/ training events & deadlines

## Increasing the number of competitive applicants to the Advanced Grant

- Proposal: annual event to collect, inspire & support prospective applicants
- Advertising: via usual channels / faculties actively identify & encourage candidates\*
- Content:
  - Significance of Advanced Grants to research agendas/ careers of award holders
  - Grantee profiles & experiences current/former award holders
  - Proposal crafting how to develop and write a competitive ERC Advanced Grant proposal
  - Information on UiB processes & support pre/post-award
- Follow-up
  - Conversation with ERC local contact to discuss research concept and plan individual support
  - Offer of UiB ERC support: ERC mentor; project & application development support from local & cental advisers (by agreement)



#### Incentives for ERC Advanced Grantees

- Current incentives (post-award)
  - 25% top up on funding universal
  - Salary increase of aprox. 120.000 NOK (agreed in 2018) universal
  - Faculty incentives (variable): further salary increase; positions (PhD; postdoc) varies per faculty
- Potential incentives (pre & post award) creating necessary time/space to focus on project development / application writing & evt. project delivery
  - Dedicated administrative support
  - Possibility for exemption from teaching/administrative work
  - Research assistant
