#### **Cheating on SDG303 exam**

One student was reported for cheating during the school exam. Thorkild Tylleskär and Kirsti Andrea Nordstrand had a meeting with the student, and the student was acquitted of cheating. Students who have not taken exams in Norway should be better prepared. Kirsti recommends that we create a standard document in MittUiB to include in all courses. This document should clearly state the regulations, especially that phones must be switched off and that talking during the exam is not allowed.

## Subject 24/24 Three-year course evaluations

In accordance with UiB's Quality System for Education, in addition to annual evaluations of individual courses, more comprehensive course evaluations should be carried out every three years. The Program Committee should make a plan for course evaluation so that all courses have completed a more thorough evaluation, including student evaluation, during a three-year period. The course coordinators are responsible for the evaluation of their courses, that a student evaluation is carried out, and for analysis and follow up the results, including preparation of proposals for improvement measures. The course which is due for evaluation this autumn is Methods in Global Health Research (INTH315). There is a special template (Encl. 3). Suggested decision: The course coordinator for INTH315 should complete the evaluation.
