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# **IUNS-ICN Conference in Paris**

### Beautiful Paris will be the site of the International Congress of Nutrition next year.

The <u>IUNS-ICN 2025</u> is scheduled for Sunday 24 August to Friday 29 August 2025. The conference is organized by the French Society of Nutrition (SFN), French Federation of Nutrition (FFN), Federation of European Nutrition Societies (FENS) and International Union of Nutritional Sciences (IUNS).

Sustainable Food for Global Health is the main theme of the conference. "Alongside this main theme, all the fundamental, clinical, epidemiological and social aspects of Nutrition will be addressed in the form of lectures, symposia, oral communications and posters", says president of SFN Jacques Delarue.

More specific topics will include the future of nutrition recommendations; climate change, sustainability and nutrition; food science, gastronomy and life quality; global health and planetary nutrition; public health and nutrition throughout life cycle; non communicable diseases; precision and clinical nutrition, and basic research in nutrition.

There is still time to <u>submit an abstract</u> for the conference! Abstract submission is possible until Friday 13 December 2024.

### NutriNOR Leadership program - Personal leadership beyond PhD

# Internship in Melk.no

NutriNOR's very first internship was completed this year - with great success! The intern was Pia Bålsrud, a PhD candidate in her final year at the University of Oslo. For three months this autumn, Pia worked at <u>Melk.no</u>, which is the Norwegian Dairy Council.

While at Melk.no, Pia worked with a wide range of assignments. For example, she contributed to the implementation of the new dietary guidelines by updating existing articles and example menus at Melk.no to comply with these guidelines. She also worked with calcium and vitamin D calculators on the website, helped to plan and organize webinars, participated in nutritional seminars, meetings, and conferences, wrote articles, answered questions from consumers, and more!

Pia learned so much during her stay at Melk.no. Through the internship, she was challenged to shift from a research-oriented perspective to a consumer-based one to understand what is of interest to consumers. "This has made me think in new ways, and it has improved my skills when it comes to communicating nutritional information to the general public." She has found that she enjoys working with consumer-oriented communication.

Furthermore, by being part of a good working environment with what she describes as extremely competent and pleasant colleagues, she has made new acquaintances. "I would absolutely recommend doing the same as me", she says at the end of her report.
