WP2: Power with Science Diplomacy - From Theory to Strategy



EU science diplomacy *theory and strategy* for power, socialization and self-reflexivity

- Goals: Effective EU-problem-solving power *with* others; communication channels; socializing European values
- How does European science diplomacy contribute to EU (member state) ability to solve third chess-board transnational chaotic problems with others, increase EU and third party ability to solve such problems?
- How does European science diplomacy contribute to socialize others to European values?
- European self-reflexivity about its role in the world
