Forslag til retningslinjer for studiekvalitetsprisen

Det psykologiske fakultet deler ut to priser årlig: undervisningsprisen og studiekvalitetsprisen. I denne saken omtaler vi studiekvalitetsprisen. Undervisningsprisen utdeles av PSF.

At fakultetet deler ut studiekvalitetsprisen ble vedtatt i fakultetsstyret i 2013, og beskrivelsen av studiekvalitetsprisen var følgende:

«Studiekvalitetsprisen gis til en foreleser eller et fagmiljø som har utviklet et undervisningsopplegg eller iverksatt et tiltak som har styrket både faglige og pedagogiske kvaliteter i undervisningen. Instituttene nominerer en foreleser eller et fagmiljø til studiekvalitetsprisen, mens KUE tildeler prisen.»

Medlemmer i KUE har ønsket tydeligere retningslinjer eller kriterier for studiekvalitetsprisen. Det virker også som om hvem som rangerer nominasjoner innenfor KUE har variert (hele KUE; visedekan for utdanning sammen med studiesjef; leder og nestleder i KUE). Forslaget til retningslinjer og prosessen er inspirert av lignende utmerkelse på andre fakulteter. Noter at tidligere har Det psykologiske fakultetet definert mulige mottakere som «en foreleser eller et fagmiljø», og dette er utvidet i de nye retningslinjene.

Forslaget til retningslinjene er følgende:

Det psykologiske fakultetet utdeler en årlig studiekvalitetspris til et institutt, fagmiljø, prosjekt, studieprogram eller emne. Formålet med prisen er å stimulere til og belønne gode studiekvalitetstiltak i fakultetets fagmiljøer. Prisen skal lyses ut årlig og deles ut etter følgende kriterier:

- Tiltaket skal bidra vesentlig til utvikling av utdanningskvaliteten.
- Overføringsverdi til andre fagmiljø/studieprogram vektlegges.
- Under ellers like vilkår vil tiltak som omfatter flere fagmiljø bli prioritert.
- Det er en fordel om tiltak er utviklet i samarbeid med studenter eller andre relevante aktører i planleggings-, gjennomførings- og oppfølgingsfasen.

Instituttene blir invitert årlig til å nominere kandidater til studiekvalitetsprisen. Forslag må begrunnes med en beskrivelse av den foreslåtte kandidaten. Forslaget bør også dokumenteres på en måte som underbygger argumentene for nominasjon av kandidaten.

En innstillingskomite bestående av fakultetets visedekan for utdanning (leder for KUE), nestlederen i KUE, og en studentrepresentant som sitter i KUE innstiller prisens vinner med utgangspunkt i de kandidatene som har blitt meldt inn. KUE (som helhet) vedtar innstillingen og tildeler prisen.

Videre nomineres vinneren til Ugleprisen, UiBs pris for utdanningskvalitet, som deles ut hver høst. Vinneren av Ugleprisen nomineres videre til den nasjonale Utdanningskvalitetsprisen for høyere utdanning. Den deles ut av Direktoratet for høyere utdanning og kompetanse (HK-dir) og er på 1 million kroner.

Visedekans kommentar

Denne saken behandles i KUE 22.2.2023 siden det var ikke tid i november 2022s møte. Saken har blitt noe revidert siden sist gang den ble presentert i KUE i 2022. Medlemmer ble invitert til å komme med innspill i forkant av dette møte.
